Purpose: To provide that if the United States Postal Service does not certify that life insurance and health insurance contributions for postal employee premiums do not exceed the maximum contribution provided for under section 8708 or 8906 of title 5, United States Code, the United States Postal Service may not receive appropriations or borrow money from the United States Treasury.

AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MCCAIN

Viz:

- 1 At the end of the bill, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. ____ . LIMITATION ON POSTAL SERVICE CONTRIBU-**
- 3 **TIONS FOR LIFE INSURANCE AND HEALTH IN-**
- 4 **SURANCE BENEFITS.**

- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the Postmaster General does
- 6 not submit a certification described under subsection (b)
- 7 to Congress before fiscal year 2012 and each fiscal year
- 8 thereafter—

1 (1) no sums may be appropriated from the
2 United States Treasury to the United States Postal
3 Service with respect to that fiscal year; and

4 (2) notwithstanding section 2005(a) of title 39,
5 United States Code, the United States Postal Serv-
6 ice may not borrow any money under that section
7 with respect to that fiscal year.

8 (b) CERTIFICATION.—A certification referred to
9 under subsection (a) is a certification that, with respect
10 to the applicable fiscal year, the contributions by the
11 United States Postal Service for employees for—

12 (1) life insurance benefits shall not exceed the
13 maximum contribution provided for under section
14 8708 of title 5, United States Code; and

15 (2) health insurance benefits shall not exceed
16 the maximum contribution provided for under sec-
17 tion 8906 of title 5, United States Code.
